#### Further accessories for Indian Chief Bobber & identical models

*D-Breisach, 6th Oct 2022* As the previous custom parts for the Indian Chief has been adopted so well, the southern German manufacturer WUNDERKIND-Custom developed and presented further accessories.

"In spring 2022, we developed numerous custom parts which gave this motorbike a new look, already. But we still missed a real Bobber style at the custom bike. That's why we've been continuing with the development. Meanwhile, our customers can fall back to a selection of almost 20 accessories to choose from. Starting with discreet design improvements over optimizations in ergonomics up to a complete rear conversion," says CEO Christian Mehlhorn.

To make the front even more compact, riser lower parts were designed to position the handlebar significantly lower. This also moves the speedometer closer to the triple clamp and thereby, the large gap with the cables hanging around gets closed. This - in combination with the accessories that have been available since spring - means that the handlebar area looks like a self-contained unit. The scope of delivery also includes a cover to mount between the risers in order to conceal the exposed cables, elegantly.

Replacement footpegs and longer replacement pedals for the original footpeg system have already scored points with their classy design and better operability. But for those who wish more legroom, a chic forward foot control is now available, too.

The highlight of the extended product portfolio is the rear conversion in a kit through which the motorcycle gets a real Bobber style. The set includes an accessory fender, struts with integrated LED turn signals and taillights as well as a bobber seat. The seat is adjustable and offers more seating comfort due to its shape and position. Moreover, a matching front fender was designed as a supplement so that rear and front visually suit well.

The already known side license plate holder is now also available in the design '2Stripes', so that this can also be combined well with the other custom parts. Because many other covers have been developed which visibly enhance the look.

The custom parts are partly compatible with other models of the same model family. Details can be found on the manufacturer's website. All accessories comply with the German Road Traffic Licensing Regulations (StVO) or have a parts certificate. Further information: WUNDERKIND-Custom.com








Riser lower parts for laying handlebar / speedometer with a cap to cover the cables




Example of the cover serie: cap for the end of standpipe tubes


